

## **Light Type Approval Scheme for Communication Equipment**

Applicant should be committed to following steps if Light Scheme has been decided for product type approval (Applicant should read Type Approval Scheme Determination Flow Chart published in type approval section in the NTRA website to know which scheme is applied for his/her product).

1) The applicant should submit contents of Table I for each model:

Table I: Type Approval Application Contents

<b>Samples required</b>	<b>For local applicants:</b> One Final sample from each model. <b>For overseas applicants:</b> No samples are required unless explicitly mentioned.			No samples required unless explicitly mentioned.
<b>Documents required</b>	1- Complete test reports of: 1-1) Radio Frequency (RF) Compliance. 1-2) Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC). 1-3) Safety. 1-4) Specific Absorption Rate (SAR).  Test reports should be according to CE or FCC or IEC standards and must be issued by NTRA accredited labs (listed in DoC 03).  2- Data Sheet & Operational Description of the product. 3- Declaration of Conformity Certificate. 4- Type Approval Application Form.  <b>Notes:</b> - <b>For local applicants</b> , documents required above should be submitted as hard copy except test reports, which should be submitted on a CD. - <b>For overseas applicants</b> , all required documents are accepted to be sent by email through a download link.			

2) In case submitted documents and samples are accepted, applicant should pay the applied type approval fees indicated in Table II.

3) Product Type Approval is processed. Applicant has right to request for Type approval certificate without additional fees.

**Notes:**

- Applicant has to follow either CE or FCC labeling requirement for the device and its package box plus adding importer name on the package box.
- For mobile phone or cellular tablet shipments the importer should send an email to [typesapprovalimei@gmail.com](mailto:typesapprovalimei@gmail.com) including one excel sheet for each model with information & format shown in Fig.1

- NTRA has the right to randomly collect samples from any shipment and inspect them before initiating the clearance permit even if the models in the shipment are already type approved and testing fees in Table II will be applied.
- Applicant has the right to take back all samples submitted within 45 after their submission date.
